Constituents within the areas of Mililani and Mililani Mauka received a short survey that gauged how community members felt about certain topics including infrastructure improvements, ideas for legislation, and areas that should be addressed in the 2023 legislative session. A total of 197 responses were received from the surveys online and mailed to households in House District 38, Mililani and Mililani Mauka.

### Methodology

Data was collected from survey responses that were returned via mail as well as an online version of the survey posted on RepMatsumoto.com. Online, an effort was made to collect survey responses from District 38 constituents only by asking survey respondents if they were District 38 constituents and asked them to select the zip code that applied.

Survey respondents who attempted to complete the survey online but were not constituents were directed to the Hawaii State Capitol website at <u>https://www.capitol.hawaii.gov/</u> to use the search box in the upper right-hand corner to find their legislators.





Question 1: What are the top 5 areas that should be addressed in the 2025 legislative session for the State?






#### Question 1 – Survey Responses Pie Chart




**Question 2:** (Online Survey) What do you feel is the number one area that should be addressed in the 2023 legislative session for the state?
