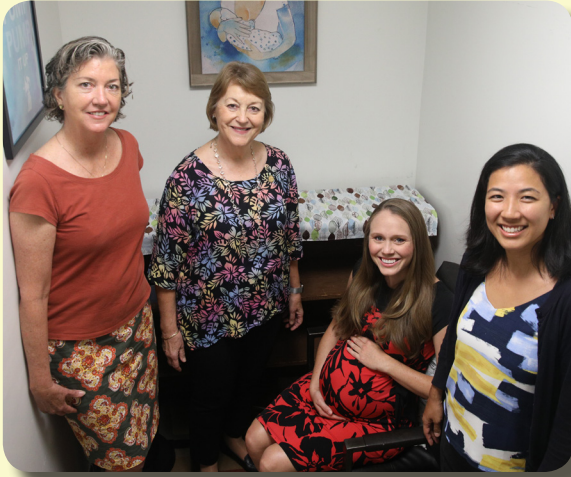

### Waialua Elementary Halloween Trunk or Treat

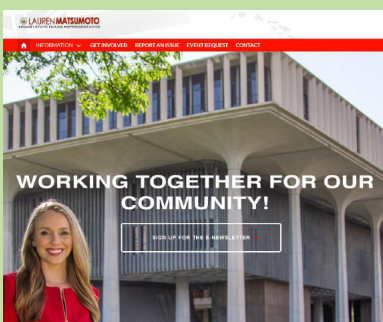
