Summary

Constituents within the areas of Mililani and Mililani Mauka received a short survey that gauged community members opinions on certain issues being discussed this legislative session. A total of 689 responses were received from the surveys online and mailed to households in House District 38, Mililani and Mililani Mauka. The online survey, which was available to all members of the public, received 14 responses from outside the district.

In the following pages, there will be data that displays the range of important topics for questions that were asked in the survey. Following the data chart, there will be a pie chart that shows the percentage.

Note: The complete survey questionnaire is included in this document for reference.

Methodology

Data was collected from survey responses that were returned via mail as well as an online version of the survey posted on RepMatsumoto.com. Online, an effort was made to collect survey responses from District 38 constituents only by asking survey respondents to select the area in the district that applied to them. We also provided an "other" option for individuals outside the district to fill out.

Note: The results reported can only be considered the opinions of the survey participants. They cannot be generalized to represent the entire client population as a whole.



Question 1: Do you support free community college funded by tax dollars for all Hawaii residents?



Question 1 – Survey Responses Pie Chart




Explanation: The question asked participants if they supported state-funded college for Hawaii residents. From the results, we can see that the majority of participants do not support this idea.


Question 2 – Survey Responses Pie Chart



3. Should minors have access to medical services related to gender transitioning?





Question 4.a - Survey Responses Pie Chart






Explanation: This question asked participants if gambling should be legalized in Hawaii. From the results, we can see that the majority of participants do not think gambling should be legal in Hawaii.

Question 4.b: If yes, do you support lottery, casinos, and/or sports betting (check all that apply)?



















Question 8 - Survey Responses Pie Chart




